CAT ADOPTION POLICIES

Our mission is to place our rescued cats in loving indoor only homes by matching them to the personalities of their new owners. In order to assure proper placement, all potential adopters are screened, vet references are checked and if you rent, approval by your landlord is required prior to placement. We ask college students to provide approval for adoption by their parents as well. Please ask an O'Malley volunteer for an application or visit us at www.omalleyalleycat.com and click on the adoption policy link.

All of our cats have received the following medical care, which averages \$150 per cat:

- Status of feline leukemia and FIV confirmed
- Vaccinations appropriate for the age of the cat - includes feline leukemia and rabies
- Microchipped
- Treated for worms, fleas, ear mites, ringworm, etc., if needed
- All cats are required to be spayed or neutered – No EXCEPTIONS

Note: We use only vet approved flea treatment such as Advantage, Revolution or Frontline. Some chemicals in store bought flea treatments can be hazardous or fatal to cats.

Our adoption fee is only \$75 for one or \$125 for two (other donations are happily accepted)!

NOTE: ALL PETS IN HOUSEHOLD MUST BE SPAYED OR NEUTERED BEFORE ANY ADOPTION BY O'MALLEY IS APPROVED. FURTHERMORE, WE NOT TYPICALLY ADOPT TO FAMILIES WITH CHILDREN UNDER 5. HOWEVER, WE WILL MAKE AN EXCEPTION PROVIDED THE CHILD HAS GROWN UP WITH CATS.

O'Malley does not allow its rescued cats or kittens to be declawed. We can, however, find a needy kitty for you that has already been declawed. If you would like further information as to why we feel so strongly against that procedure, please email feralaristocat@yahoo.com for more information.
